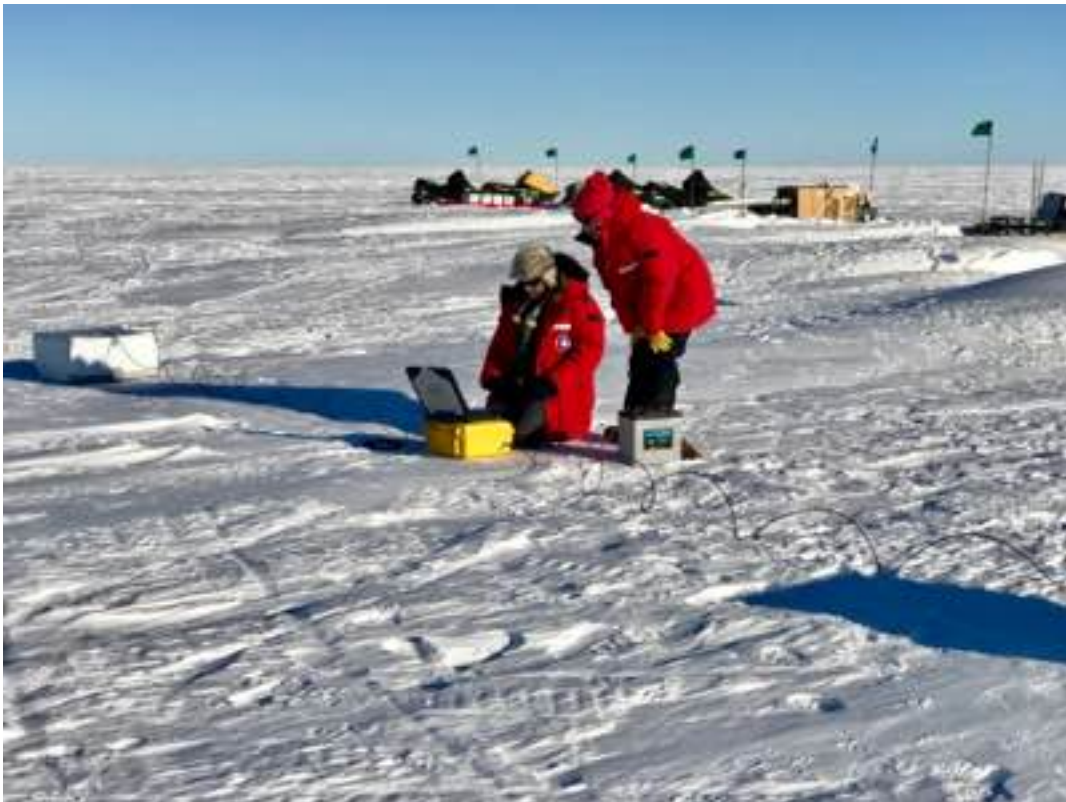


SALSA Field Report: 24 Nov 2018. Compiled by Matt Siegfried.

SALSA Geophysics/SALSA EM, Day 25 Update

Weather was unexpectedly great when we woke up, so we got right back on the science train. Two more magnetotelluric stations in along a transect that crossing the Whillans Ice Stream grounding line.

- Matt started prepping gear to service GPS stations and to install a long-term phase sensitive radar station on Ross Ice Shelf.
