SALSA Geophysics/SALSA EM, Location: Mercer Subglacial Lake

- After two days on the road, the team took the morning off to catch up on rest.

- In the afternoon, we started in on unpacking our eight sleds. We also will visit three of our year-round GPS stations on the way to download data and make sure the station will survive another Antarctic winter. The final two year-round GPS stations will be serviced by air.
